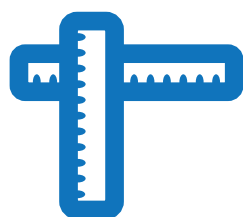
Monitor and support learning along the way

For advanced evaluation of programmes, 360 degrees questionnaires are also available. You can decide to make evaluation a mandatory requirement for the completion of courses/programmes and the delivery of certificates.
